

CIRCULAR FOR CLASS XI STUDENTS

Dear Parent,

As you are aware that all CBSE Schools are following CCE pattern upto class X where the child is assessed on the basis of his/her performance in scholastic & co-scholastic areas.

In Class XI, the assessment is purely on scholastic areas and there is a vast difference in the syllabus of XI as compared to X. As per the CBSE Examination rule 40.2 circular dated 15.01.2012, a student can be given compartment only in one subject and if a student fails in two or more subjects he/she is not eligible for the promotion to class XII.


More seriousness is required at this level as the child has to prepare himself for Board exam as well as for other competitive exams.

Every cycle test and term exams are mandatory and will be assessed for the promotion. Weightage given to tests and term exams would be as follows:
