**Pg.No.1**

Paste a family photograph ( if you have a pet at home then include it too. )

Child should be able to :

Recognize all the family members in the photograph by simply answering the question

- ❖ Who is he / she?
- ❖ She / He is my\_\_\_\_\_.

**Pg.No.2**

Paste your photograph eating a fruit , a vegetable and a sweet dish which you enjoyed during your summer holidays

Child should be able to answer:

- ❖ Which fruit/ vegetable / sweet dish / drink did you enjoy in your holidays.

**Pg.No.3**

Paste photograph of your visit to a temple of Jaipur

Child should be able to answer:

- ❖ Which temple did you visit?





**Pg.No.4**

Paste photograph of your visit to a famous monument of Jaipur.

Child should be able to answer:

- ❖ Which monument did you visit?
- ❖ What is it famous for?

**Pg.No.5**

If you went out of Jaipur then paste a picture

- Of your journey.
- Of the place you visited.
- People you met.

Child should be able to answer:

- ❖ Which place did you visit?
- ❖ How did you go?
- ❖ Whom did you meet?

**Or**

If you were in Jaipur then paste picture of

- Guest who came to meet you.
- Any place you took them for outing.

Child should be able to answer:

- ❖ Who came to your house?
- ❖ Where did you take your guest for outing?

**Pg.No.6**

Paste your photograph of yours while helping your elders at home.

Child should be able to answer:

- ❖ Whom did you help ?
- ❖ How did you help?

**Pg.No.7**

Paste your photograph watering the plants and keeping a bird feeder outdoors.

Child should be able to answer:

- ❖ How many pots did you water?
- ❖ How many times in a day did you water?
- ❖ Did you see any birds eating grains?


**Pg.No.8**
