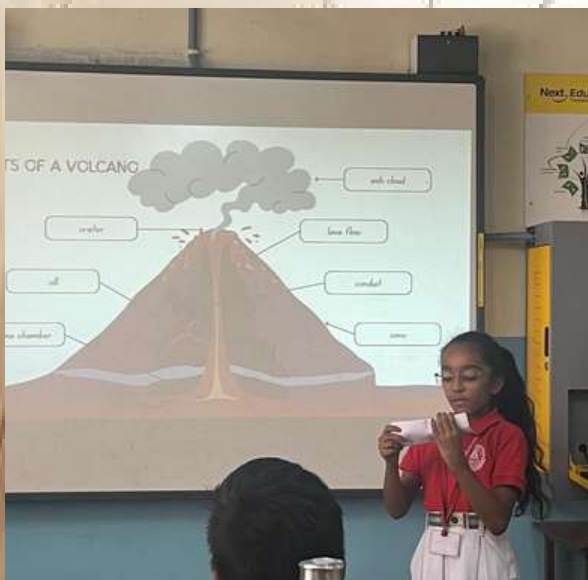


Leaf Art Activity
