**Minutes of the PTA Meeting held on 18.07.2023**

The meeting of Parents-Teacher Association (PTA) for the academic year 2023-24 held on 18.7.2023 at 1:00 pm in the School Auditorium.

300 PTA members were present in the meeting.

1. The meeting commenced with a welcome note.
2. **Agenda 1 – Introduction of the Principal:** Smt. Suman Joshi, Secretary, PTA introduced Ms. Preeti Sangwan, Principal, Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan Vidyashram, K.M.Munshi Marg, Jaipur.
3. **Agenda 2 – Academic Performance & Improvement Plan:** The Principal extended a warm welcome to the members of PTA and gave a brief account of the:
  - (a) Academic achievements of the school.
  - (b) National Education Policy – 2020 and NCF.
  - (c) Based on NEP & NCF, proposed initiatives were shared. The initiatives included:- Financial Literacy Programmes, Tinkering Lab, Career Counseling Programmes.
4. **Agenda 3 – Sports & Co-curricular Activities Plan:** Parents were informed about Bhavan's Sports Academies and Visual Performing Art activities offered by Suruchi Kendra.
  - (i) Sports offered by academies are: Badminton, Lawn Tennis, Football, Cricket, Basketball, Skating, Martial Art & Squash
  - (ii) Suruchi Kendra offers: Kathak, Bharatnatyam, visual performing art activities – Guitar, Keyboard & Drums.

To enhance the quality and accessibility of sports opportunities, a proposal to increase sports hour per week was put forth.

5. **Agenda 4 - Process of Constitution of the School Level Fee Committee (SLFC):** The PTA members were informed about the purpose of forming the SLFC, procedure and composition of SLFC and the proposed timeline for the same in the ongoing academic year.

6. Agenda 5 - Any other points : Parents suggested the following in the Open House Session: -

(a) Suggestions

1	Children need to be prepared for competitive exams at higher levels or integrated system of collaboration with coaching centres for competitive examinations to be introduced
2.	Students need to be encouraged to cross question.
3.	Meditation and de-stressing sessions to be arranged
4	Bag weight in the primary wing must be reduced.
5.	Feed backs must be taken from students.
6.	Students must be encouraged for developing the habit of reading newspapers, current affairs and attending and expressing themselves in assemblies to improve spoken English.
8	Cooling system in a few class rooms to be checked.

(b) A few parents appreciated the work done by the school teachers and the value system of the school.

(c) Members were informed that appropriate plan and action would be taken to address the issues.
